9 th -12 th grade youth:	Settlers	6-day, 5-night program, Sun-Fri

Activities:

Pioneers & Pathfinders: Arts & crafts, field games, swimming and waterfront activities*, nature exploration, archery, worship, Bible study, evening campfires, cook-outs

Mavericks & Settlers: Arts & crafts, field games, swimming and waterfront activities*, nature exploration, archery, worship, Bible study, evening campfires, cook-outs, overnight campout

** All swimming and waterfront activities are supervised by certified lifeguards. Campers must pass a swim test to be able to swim in above-knee-deep water on our lakes. Campers who do not pass or do not take our swim test must wear lifejackets (provided by camp) in certain areas of our waterfront.*

Campers are supervised at all times by trained camp staff. All campers are housed in cabin groups by program consisting of 5-9 fellow campers and a cabin leader. Cabin groups participate in all camp activities together and are accompanied and supervised by cabin leaders and other highly trained camp staff.

8:15pm Campfire

9:00pm Cabin time

10:00pm Lights out**
